Faculty Development Grant for Part-time Pediatric Dental Educators

Introduction:

The California Society of Pediatric Dentistry Foundation is interested in assisting the pediatric dental programs at the five California dental schools and non-affiliated programs with the recruitment and retention of without salary clinicians to teach part time in the dental educational system.

The grant will provide a maximum of \$5000 to each school in any one year to attract and retain clinicians who desire to be teachers and to offer an alternative to normal retirement practices, bringing mid to late career clinicians into the educational system.

Requirements:

A 2-3 page description of the proposed project will be required including how the project meets the objectives of the grant program and must include measurements of success and continuing education credit. A detailed budget is also required.

Topics that may be of interest include:

- Teaching/testing methodologies
- Counseling, mentoring
- Research
- Behavior Management
- Clinical updates
- Ethics and professionalism
- Practice management

University wide (i.e. school of Education) and/or collaboration with other dental schools is recommended.

At the conclusion of the project, the grant recipient will submit a report of attendance, activities and outcome measures relevant to the proposed program no later than two months after the project is completed.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be 1) the Pediatric Dental chairperson at each of the California Dental Schools or his/her designate or non-university affiliated Pediatric Dental program directors and 2) a member of the CSPD.
